**ADMISSION TO 'LITTLE HEARTS'
INTERNATIONAL PLAY SCHOOL & Nursery**

- 1) Registration starts on 1st December, of every year.
- 2) Date of birth should be according to government rules for admission in all classes.
- 3) Original date of birth certificate is required to validate age of the child at the time of admission.

ADMISSION PROCEDURE

Admission to Nursery, LKG, UKG, class one and class two is direct, based on an interview with the child and both the parents. From class 3 to 10th the admission is based on seat availability, merit shown in Entrance Test and on previous performances shown in the Report Card. If the Admission is confirmed after an interview call from the school office, parents can secure admission with the guarantee of producing TC within one month of admission from previously enrolled school. The name of the child will be entered in the School Rolls, only after the payment of prescribed fees. Aadhar card & passport size photograph in school uniform should be presented at the office during the admission period of one week.

Medium of Instruction - The medium of instruction is English.

Second Language - From 9th STD onwards, option is available to choose Hindi / Sanskrit /Marathi.

Additional/Skill Subject - Other than the regular five subjects students can choose any one of the following subjects for their board examinations if they are interested. 1. Healthcare 2. Marketing & Sales 3. Introduction to financial Market. 4. Banking and Insurance 5. Beauty and Wellness 6. Information Technology.

In the board examination, skill subject's marks can be substituted to any one of the main subject's, like Mathematics, Science or Social Science.

Facility

Lush Green Campus - A pollution free picturesque green environment await each student. The Campus is spread over an area of seven acres, it has plenty of trees and is easily accessible by public transport

Smart - Class :- Smart class is transforming the way teachers teach and students learn in schools. It's a technological revolution that is fast becoming an imperative for schools. It has world-class technology-enabled teaching tools in which special classrooms are created, equipped with projectors and a PC for teachers. Through the Knowledge Centre, excellent teaching resources such as animation clips, videos, pictures, diagrams and working models are brought straight into the classrooms. It makes learning an enjoyable experience for students.

Computer Lab :- The school has two fully equipped computer Labs where a complete class can be catered to at one go. The students have free access to the systems and are encouraged to exploit this resource, highly experienced and talented Teachers are available to support them.

OTHER DETAILS

- *15% of the fees would increase every two years. Fee was last hiked in 2025-26; Next fee hike is in 2027-2028
- * Any type of argument regarding fees is not allowed after admission. Clear all the doubts about fees before taking the admission. Fees once paid will not be refundable.
- *T.C. will be issued within one month of application.
- *Students who have not paid the school fees on time will be removed from rolls.

SCHOOL BUSES

The school bus facility covers most parts of Bhandara town. Bus fees depend on the distance. Bus facility can be availed only for the whole year and not on monthly basis. This is to avoid monthly change in bus pick-up timings of other students. To register, you must pay Rs.10/- in the school office, determine the cost of bus fees for the whole year based on distance and pay the amount in maximum two installments at the bank. A bus pass will be issued from the School Office when you submit the bus fee receipt. Students without a bus pass will not be dropped back home.

:: TEXT BOOKS ::

Students who cleared the school fees should send a request with an advance of Rs.2000/- for books. Then they will receive books from the school. The total amount will be informed later.

Tiffin Rule : Students eat their tiffin in the supervision of their class teachers. We normally encourage the children to finish the entire food given by parents and will not allow them to waste the food. If the tiffin is not fully finished by the child, the balance food will be put back in the tiffin itself, so that parents get an idea about the eating habit of their child. Parents should take care that the children do not have junk foods in their tiffin box. Green salads & Fruits are necessary with a protein rich-lunch box.
